Stage 3 - PJ Challenge

Stage Designer: Bob B @ MWT and Lee



Scenario: You are the first responder to a downed, injured pilot behind enemy lines.

Start Position: Standing at either P1 (straddling PVC pipe) downed pilot in support hand (use harness)

Firearm Condition: IDPA weapon loaded to division capacity, holstered, and concealed.

Procedure: At the signal, engage targets either stationary or moving while holding pilot with support hand. If shooter reaches P2, you may release the pilot and engage any or all targets freestyle from either side of barricade using cover. You may put pilot down to reload before reaching P2, but must have pilot in support hand while engaging targets unless you are behind cover at P2. At P2, targets must be engaged in tactical priority. Before reaching P2, all targets are considered in the open and there is no cover.

Identify points of cover (PoC) and fault lines: Refer to diagram below and identified in the walkthrough.

Muzzle Safe Points: Floating 180 degree rule

Scored Hits: 16 **Scoring:** Unlimited
