



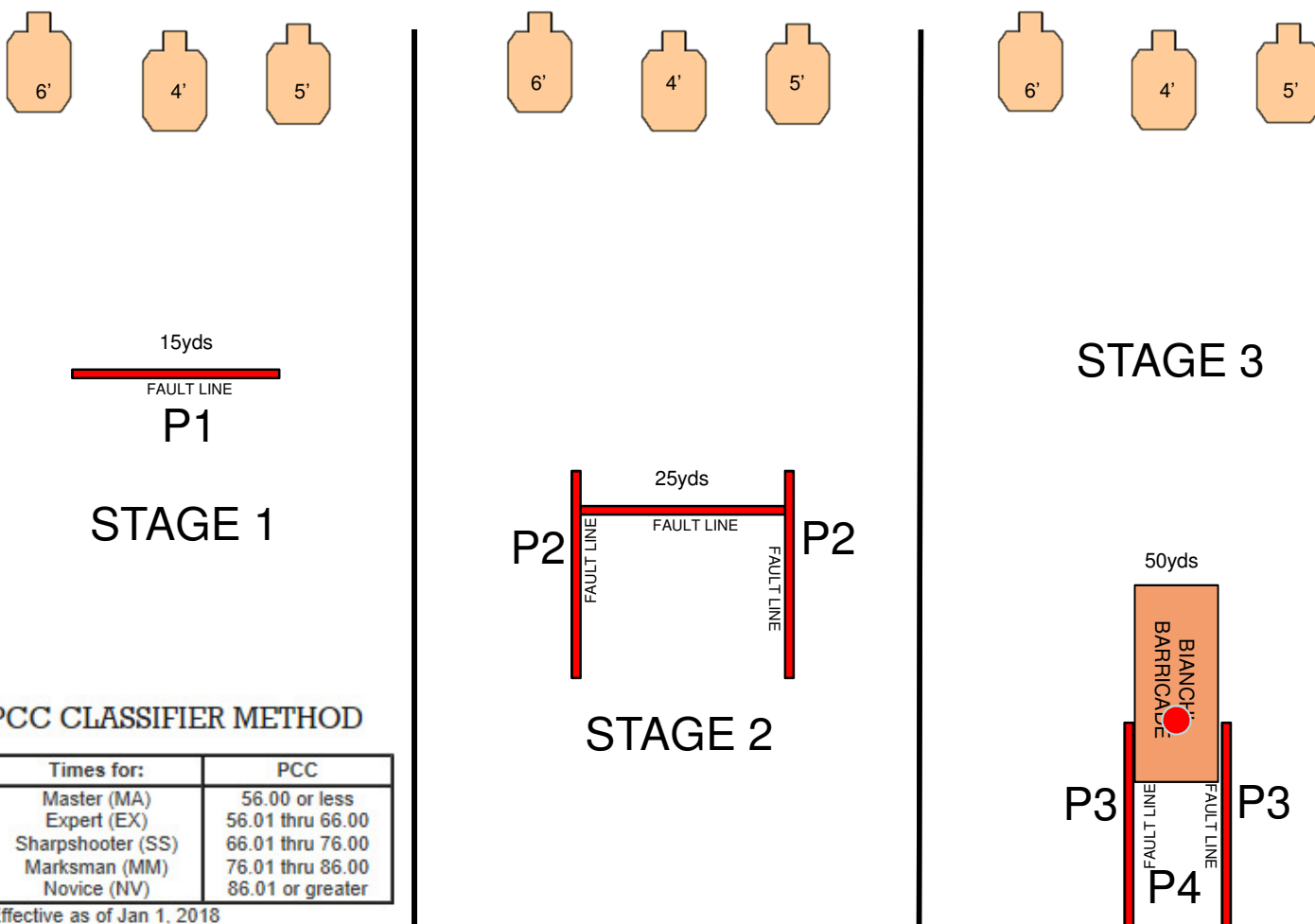

PCC Classifier

Stage Designer: IDPA

Scenario: Standards
Start Position: Per stage/String description
Firearm Condition: PCC loaded to division capacity unless stated otherwise in stage/string description.
<p>Procedure: Stage 1/String 1 – From low ready, fire 2 shots to the body and 1 to the head on T2, then 2 shots to the body and 1 to the head on T1 and T3 in any order. Stage 1/String 2 – From Low Ready, fire 3 shots to the head of T2, then 3 shots to the head of T1 and T3 in any order.</p> <p>Stage 2 – Load exactly 9 rounds in the firearm at either P2. From Low Ready fire 3 rounds to each target starting with T2, reload and move to the opposite P2 and re-engage each target with 3 shots each starting with T2.</p> <p>Stage 3/String 1 – From Low Ready at either P3, fire 3 rounds to each target offhand starting with T2. Stage 3/String 2 – From P4 with muzzle touching mark on Barricade, fire 3 shots on each target from either side of the Barricade in tactical priority.</p>
Identify points of cover (PoC) and fault lines: Refer to diagram below and identified in the walkthrough.
Muzzle Safe Points: Floating 180 degree rule
Scored Hits: 18/18/18 Scoring: Limited
SO Notes: Bay 1A Targets: 9 IDPA
