



# Little River Sportsman's Association IDPA

## Stage 1 – Bartender Blues

Stage Designer: Lee Ovaert



<b>Scenario:</b> You are working late at the bar when the whiskey runs low and the good old boys come after you.	
<b>Start Position:</b> Standing at P1 (straddling PVC pipe), towel in weak hand, spray bottle in strong hand, hands touching the table.	
<b>Firearm Condition:</b> IDPA pistol loaded to division capacity, holstered, and concealed. PCC loaded below the table on the crossbrace on the shooters strong side, pointing safely downrange.	
<b>Procedure:</b> At the signal, spray Bubba (non-threat) in the face with cleaner, the engage targets in front of you and to the left from above the table. Targets to the right must be engaged from low cover. (at least one knee on the ground, below the fault line) Paper targets are engaged with at least 2 rounds each, steel must fall to score.	
<b>Identify points of cover (PoC) and fault lines:</b> Refer to diagram below and identified in the walkthrough.	
<b>Muzzle Safe Points:</b> Floating 180 degree rule	
<b>Scored Hits:</b> 14	<b>Scoring:</b> Unlimited
<b>SO Notes:</b> Bay 5 Targets: 6 IDPA, 1 Non-threats, 2 Steel Plates, 1 Vision Barrier (VB)
