Stage 6 - Bay of Pigs

RULES: IDPA COURSE DESIGNER: Lee Turner

START POSITION: Walking down the wooded trail. IDPA weapon loaded to IDPA division capacity and holstered.

SCENARIO: You are hiking through the woods when you notice a group of wild pigs in the woods.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Indicate shooter is ready by beginning to walk down the trail. At the signal, the pigs notice you and begin to attack. Engage any threats with at least 2 rounds, moving as required.

SOs remind shooters about muzzle discipline.

Use of cover is not required. These hogs are unarmed.

SCORING: Vickers

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: IDPA Scoring MIN ROUND COUNT: 12
