

# Stage 6 - Bay of Pigs

**RULES:** IDPA

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Lee Turner

<b>START POSITION:</b> Walking down the wooded trail. IDPA weapon loaded to IDPA division capacity and holstered.	
<b>SCENARIO:</b> You are hiking through the woods when you notice a group of wild pigs in the woods.  <b>STAGE PROCEDURE:</b> Indicate shooter is ready by beginning to walk down the trail. At the signal, the pigs notice you and begin to attack. Engage any threats with at least 2 rounds, moving as required. <b>SOs remind shooters about muzzle discipline.</b>  <b>Use of cover is not required. These hogs are unarmed.</b>	<b>SCORING:</b> Vickers <b>START-STOP:</b> Audible - Last shot <b>PENALTIES:</b> IDPA Scoring <b>MIN ROUND COUNT:</b> 12  6 Shoot Targets 0 No Shoot Targets  <b>BAY 4</b>



I'm not about to draw this one. Targets will be all less than 10 yards. Targets are Down 0 and Down 1 only, turned 90 degrees clockwise and counterclockwise randomly. Approx 21 inches to top of head area. First 2 clearly visible. Remaining 4 hidden/partially hidden requiring movement.
